Corporate Compliance – Standards of Conduct AD.CC70

POLICY:

The Standards of Conduct of Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care expresses a commitment to comply with Federal, State and private insurer standards and requires ethical conduct and business practices of all hospice employees, volunteers, and independent contractors.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The Board of Directors is responsible for the revision of the *Standards of Conduct* when statutes and/or regulations are modified.
- 2. A copy of the *Standards of Conduct* is provided to all new employees, volunteers, Board members and, when appropriate, independent contractors, with whom the hospice conducts business.
- 3. All employees and volunteers are required to certify that they have received, read, and understood the *Standards of Conduct* at the time of hire and if/when revisions occur. A copy of this certification is retained in the personnel file of each employee and volunteer.
- 4. Board members, hospice employees, volunteers and independent contractors working with Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care are expected to adhere to the hospice's *Standards of Conduct*.
- 5. Board members, hospice employees, volunteers and independent contractors have a responsibility to report any conduct or business practices that do not conform to the *Standards of Conduct*.
- 6. A commitment to follow the hospice's *Standards of Conduct* is expected of all individuals who work for or with Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care.
