HIPAA Privacy – Minimum Necessary Uses of PHI

POLICY:

Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care's co-workers and volunteers use and/or have access to the minimum amount of protected health information (PHI) necessary to perform their job functions effectively.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The hospice identifies the co-workers and volunteers who need access to PHI according to the categories of uses for treatment, payment or health care operations.
- 2. The hospice identifies the type and minimum amount of PHI needed by co-workers and volunteers to perform their jobs effectively.
- 3. The hospice determines the circumstances under which co-workers and volunteers may use PHI.
- 4. All members of the Interdisciplinary Group (IDG) and others who provide and coordinate treatment for the hospice's patients have access to the patient's entire medical record.
- All co-workers and volunteers are required to use PHI in accordance with the determination made by Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care of the minimum amount necessary to effectively perform their jobs.
- 6. When a co-worker performs more than one job function, the types of protected health information and conditions for access is dependent on the capacity in which the co-worker is functioning.

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
