HIPAA Privacy – Notice of Privacy Practices POLICY:

AD.HP40

The privacy practices of Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care are clearly delineated in the hospice's *Notice of Privacy Practices* that was developed and is used in accordance with Federal requirements.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The privacy practices of Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care are described in the *Notice of Privacy Practices* and are further explained in the hospice's privacy policies and procedures.
- 2. The *Notice of Privacy Practices* is given to all patients no later than the date of the first service delivery and is available to anyone who requests it.
- 3. A good faith effort is made to obtain written acknowledgement of the patient's receipt of the hospice's *Notice of Privacy Practices*.
- 4. When written acknowledgement of the patient's receipt of the *Notice of Privacy Practices* cannot be obtained, there is documentation to explain efforts made to obtain it and the reason(s) why it was not obtained.
- 5. The *Notice of Privacy Practices* is revised as needed to reflect any changes in the hospice's privacy practices. Revisions to the *Notice of Privacy Practices* are not implemented prior to the effective date of the revised *Notice*.
- 6. When revisions to the *Notices of Privacy Practices* are necessary, all current patients, co-workers, and business associates receive a revised copy with a notation of the changes made.
- 7. The Privacy Officer or designee retains copies of the original *Notice of Privacy Practices* and any subsequent revisions for a period of six years from the date of its creation or when it was last in effect, whichever is later.
- 8. Documentation is retained for six years of the patient's written acknowledgment of receipt of the hospice's *Notice of Privacy Practices* or of efforts made to obtain this written acknowledgment and the reason(s) why it was not obtained.
- 9. All co-workers and business associates of Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care are required to adhere to the privacy practices as detailed in the *Notice of Privacy Practices*, privacy policies and procedures and business associate contracts.
- 10. Violations of the hospice's privacy practices result in disciplinary action up to and including termination of employment or contracts.
- 11. The *Notice of Privacy Practices* is posted in a clear and prominent location at the hospice and on the hospice's website.
