HIPAA SECURITY: WORKSTATION USE AND SECURITY AD.HS85

POLICY:

Workstations (computers) that contain or have access to electronic protected health information are used and physically safeguarded in a manner that maximizes security and prevents unauthorized access.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Guidelines for the acceptable use of workstations (including desktops, laptops and handheld devices) that contain or have access to electronic protected health information are provided to hospice co-workers.
- 2. Training is provided to hospice co-workers on the guidelines for acceptable use of workstations.
- 3. Additional training is provided as needed to ensure authorized users understand necessary procedures for compliance with the guidelines (for example, enabling password protected screensavers or logging off procedures).
