POLICY: Employees are expected to present a professional appearance when representing Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Employees are expected to exercise good judgment in choosing appropriate clothing for work and care in grooming, personal hygiene and cleanliness.
- 2. Employees are required to wear the official hospice ID Badge while on duty.
- 3. The following types of clothing are specifically not permitted for staff:
 - a. sandals, flip flops or other open toe shoes (for staff engaging in direct patient care);
 - b. halters, tank tops or shirts with spaghetti straps;
 - c. T-shirts;
 - d. denim fabric clothing of any kind;
 - e. sweat pants or jogging suits; and
 - f. clothing that is excessively tight or revealing
- 4. Employees are expected to attend to their personal grooming and hygiene with the following guidelines:
 - a. hair should be clean and nicely groomed;
 - b. men should be shaven with facial hair well-groomed;
 - c. fingernails should be trimmed and clean and at a professional length
 - d. no offensive tattoos or body art should be visible employees with explicit or graphic tattoos must make attempts to cover these with clothing, make-up or by other means;
 - e. body piercing should not be excessive; and
 - f. perfume, cologne or after shave should not be used.
