## Volunteers -Retention, Support and Education HR.V35

**Regulation(s):** 42 CFR 418.78(c)

**L-Tag(s):** 645

**POLICY:** Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care documents and demonstrates viable and ongoing efforts to retain, support and provide continuing education opportunities.

## **PROCEDURES:**

- 1. Efforts are made to retain and support hospice volunteers through:
  - a. a formal Volunteer Recognition event held annually during National Volunteer Month;
  - b. regular and consistent contact with the Volunteer Coordinator and other members of hospice's IDG; and
  - c. attendance at IDG meetings, when possible.
- 2. Continuing education opportunities for volunteers include:
  - a. notification of and invitation to in-services provided to hospice staff; and
  - b. two (2) specialized in-services per year on topics relevant to patient care volunteers.
- 3. The Volunteer Coordinator tracks and trends volunteer retention and turnover and reports findings to the hospice Executive Director, Director of Clinical Operations and QAPI on a quarterly basis.

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
