## Admission Orders PC.A20

**POLICY:** Patients admitted to Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care have a physician's order for care.

## PROCEDURE:

- 1. The hospice obtains orders from a physician according to law and regulation and professional standards of practice before providing care.
- 2. Oral and telephone orders are put in writing and signed and dated with the date of receipt by the individual accepting the order.
- 3. Only personnel authorized to do so by applicable State or Federal laws and regulations may accept verbal orders from a physician. In the state of Pennsylvania this includes physicians, registered nurses and licensed practical nurses.
- 4. The hospice nurse is responsible for confirming the admission orders with the patient's attending physician (if there is one) or the hospice physician.
- 5. The admission orders are sent to the physician's office for signature and upon receipt by the hospice, placed in the patient's clinical record. Physician's orders must be signed within 7 days of receipt.
