Complementary Therapies PC.C30

POLICY: Complementary therapies are offered when appropriate for symptom management and/or as an adjunct to promote quality of life.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Complementary therapies that may be provided include, but are not limited to:
 - a. acupuncture;
 - b. aromatherapy;
 - c. expressive therapy;
 - d. reflexology;
 - e. hypnosis; and
 - f. massage.
- 2. Complementary therapies are provided by qualified hospice employees, volunteers, or contracted providers under the supervision and professional management of the interdisciplinary group.
- 3. The provision of complementary therapies is included in the patient's plan of care and based on assessed need.
- 4. A physician's order for complementary therapies is obtained when required.
