Continuity of Care PC.C40

Regulation(s): 42 CFR 418.56(e)(4)

L-Tag(s): 557

POLICY: Lifesong Hospice and Palliative Care assures the continuity of care for the patient and caregiver(s) in the home, outpatient and inpatient settings.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. All disciplines providing services to the patient/family follow established communication mechanisms to ensure that services continue without interruption whenever there are changes to the patient's level of care or care setting.
- The hospice's transfer, revocation and discharge policies and procedures are followed to assure continuity of care and well-coordinated transitions for patient/family and other service providers.
- 3. Education regarding the hospice philosophy of care and the patient's hospice plan of care is provided to other providers as needed when there is a change in the patient's care setting.
- 4. The clinical records of patients transferring to a different level of care or care setting contain detailed information that promotes continuity of care.
- 5. The hospice obtains copies of clinical records from other providers as warranted to ensure continuity of care and accurate billing.

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
