Hospice Aide Services PC.H25

Regulation(s): 42 CFR 418.76 **L-Tag(s):** 607, 608, 609, 610

POLICY: Individuals who currently meet the personnel requirements specified in hospice regulations and who have successfully completed a competency evaluation program as required by regulations, provide hospice aide services under the supervision of a hospice registered nurse.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The hospice ensures that there are enough hospice aides employed by the hospice to meet the needs of its patients.
- If necessary, the hospice contracts with other entities to provide hospice aides and ensures that the
 overall quality of services provided, and the qualifications of the contract aides meet regulatory
 requirements.
- 3. Hospice aide services are assigned based on the comprehensive assessment and reassessment of the patient's personal care needs and ability to perform activities of daily living.
- 4. The hospice RN develops a written hospice aide plan of care that provides instructions to the hospice aide on the frequency of services and of the patient-specific care to be provided.
- 5. The hospice aide's services are ordered by the IDG, included in the patient's plan of care and are consistent with the hospice aide's training.

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
